

Silent Symptoms

Step into the world of silent diagnosis! This fun communication challenge checks how well you can “read lips” and make sense without sound. One player mouths a medical term or phrase while the next person wearing noise-cancelling earphones must figure it out using lip movements alone. The results are often unexpected, surprising and always hilarious!

Eligibility Criteria:

- Open to all undergraduate medical students.
- 5 teams with 4 participants in each team.

Guidelines:

- The first player receives a medical term or phrase.
- They must mouth (soundlessly speak) the word to the next player.
- Each player in turn tries to pass the word to the next, all while wearing headphones with music on.
- The final participant says the word aloud and the team discovers how much the message changed along the way!
- Points will be awarded based on accuracy, team coordination and time efficiency.

- The participant who first reaches the final square shall be declared the winner.

Med Debate

MedDebate brings 8 teams into a fast-paced arena where medical ethics takes center stage. Prepare your arguments, defend your position and compete to become the Ethical Champions.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Open to any undergraduate MBBS student.
- 8 teams with 3 members in each

Debate Format:

Round 1:

- Four topics will be provided for preparation in advance during registration.
- Topics and sides for the teams will be given on the spot through a chit-based draw.
- Speaking format: 1 minute for the introduction, 1 minute for addressing the chosen topic, 1 minute for the conclusion, 30 seconds for the questioning segment.
- Winners from this round will advance to Round 2.

Round 2:

- Topic will be assigned on the spot.
- Speaking format: 1.5 minutes for the introduction, 1.5 minutes for the main discussion, 1.5 minutes for the conclusion, 1 minute for the questioning segment.
- Winners from this round will advance to the Finals.

Round 3 (Final round):

- The final topic will be assigned on the spot.
- Speaking format: 2 minutes for the introduction, 2 minutes for the main argument, 2 minutes for the conclusion, 1 minute for the questioning segment.
- The top-performing team will be awarded the MedDebate Championship title.

Guidelines:

- Teams must prepare for the provided four topics in advance.
- Speaking order and time limits are strict. Only team discussions are allowed, no external help.
- Questioning occurs in every round.
- Judges' decisions are final. Scoring is based on clarity, logic and ethical reasoning.
